NO. NBE-20/ES-Advt. Bills/2021-22:: This is for information of all concerned that in order to streamline payment of advertisement bills and avoid confusion between conflicting claims, the following guidelines have been drawn up:

- The NBSE, functioning as an autonomous body, shall send the request for advertisement directly to the local newspapers, as presently practiced. The request shall not be routed through the DIPR.
- 2. Similarly, the newspapers shall submit the advertisement bills directly to the Chairman NBSE. Each bill must be appended with a copy of the request for the advertisement and the newspaper cutting of the advertisement (full page).
- The payment shall be made directly to the local dailies. In case of non-receipt of the
 payment, the matter shall be intimated to the Chairman NBSE and not to the DIPR or
 any other Government agency.
- 4. Payments may be made in cash, cheque or through electronic transfer according to the convenience of both the parties and depending on the prevailing situations. In all the cases, receipts shall be obtained.
- The local dailies shall forward the particulars of the authorized person to the NBSE for collection of the payment in cash or cheque.

The above guidelines are issued without prejudice and in the interest of all concerned.
