No. NBE-41/Ad-DOE/2023-24: Schools under Dimapur district and adjoining areas are reporting a surge in students contracting the Eye flu or Conjunctivitis where they are unable to attend physical classes thereby affecting their learning. Cases are being reported in Kohima and Mokokchung also.

In this regard, the Board request all the Heads of Institutions to look out for cases of Eye flu in their school and take necessary measures to contain the spread of this highly infectious disease. Students and staff should also be made aware of the symptoms, treatment and prevention of Eye flu.

In the event of students contracting the disease Eye flu in considerable numbers, physical classes may be avoided and the school can make necessary arrangements to connect with these students on a digital mode. In case, some students are not having mobile phones or devices, the school shall also pursue alternate mode of learnings. All possible steps should be taken to avoid learning loss/gaps.

All schools are therefore, requested to note the above and take necessary steps keeping in mind the interests of the students.
