## Education Sensitization Session 2025

**Tentative date:** 7<sup>th</sup> March 2025  
**Venue:** Christian Higher Secondary School Auditorium, Dimapur

**Objective:** The primary objective of the education fair will be:

- Distribution of information: To offer comprehensive information about the diverse educational opportunities available, ranging from school programs to vocational training, undergraduate, and postgraduate courses.
- Showcase trends and innovation in education: To highlight emerging trends in education, such as digital learning platforms, vocational certifications, and alternative forms of education.
- To provide career sensitization to Class XII appeared students and parents.

**Key features:**

- Networking opportunities: Students can network with admission officers, education consultants, and career professionals to explore future educational and career paths.
- Scholarship and financial information: Institutions will offer details about available scholarships, financial aid options, and how to apply for them.
- Each Institution will be given time to make their pitch.

1. **Role of Investment and Development Authority of Nagaland:** IDAN will network with all the participating Institutes for the event. The department will also take care of the venue and all the arrangement logistics.
2. **Role of the Department of School Education:** The Department of School Education will issue the information to all the Higher Secondary Schools (Government and Private, including CBSE) with the instructions to all class 12 appeared students to attend the live session. For schools without proper internet connectivity, a representative maybe instructed to join to collect all the information from the participating colleges to be shared with the students.
3. The **Department of Higher Education** can send out similar information to all the colleges since most of the participating institutes offer PG courses.
4. **Role of IT Department:** IT Department to provide internet connectivity, to broadcast the session to all the schools in the District.
5. **Role of the participating Institutions:** The Institutions will be asked to either come to Dimapur to interact physically with the students, send a power point presentation, or join the live session to interact with the students.
