NO.NBE-18/Ad-Misc(12)/2022-23: It is hereby notified for information of all that the admission and commencement of Class XI in the academic calendar 2022, was given as June/July 2022. With the improved situation, the Board examinations could be conducted successfully and the results of HSLC & HSSLC Examinations 2022 were declared on 31st May 2022. Now in order to ensure that students of Class XI get more number of teaching and learning days, Higher Secondary Institutions are advised to start their classes early. The regular classes should resume anytime from 13th June 2022 and not as mentioned in the academic calendar 2022.

Institutions should also ensure that they admit students as per their available infrastructure. Classrooms should not be crammed or crowded. Institutions should also maintain the teacher-student ratio of 1: 40.

Moreover, in continuation of Notification No. 52/2022 dated 27th May 2022, it is hereby informed that student of Arts stream desiring to opt for Mathematics as an elective subject must secure the qualifying grade in Mathematics at Class X. Further, the minimum qualification for teaching Mathematics at Higher Secondary level is Post Graduate in Mathematics with B.Ed. (*General Rules, Page 27*).

Therefore, institutions desiring to offer Mathematics as an elective subject in Arts stream are directed to apply for permission, with a copy of educational qualification of the subject teacher, within 15th June 2022 at nagaboard@gmail.com
