The identified single use plastics include ear buds with plastic sticks, plastic sticks for balloons, plastic flags, candy sticks, ice-cream sticks, polystyrene for decoration, plastic bags, plastic water bottles, plastic straws, plastic plates, plastic cups, plastic spoons, plastic knives, plastic stirrers, food packaging containers, wrapping or packing films around sweet boxes, invitation cards and cigarette packets, plastic or PVC banners less than 100 microns.

In this regard, all registered institutions are hereby directed to apprise the students as well as the parents and the community about the awareness campaigns and to take measures in practicing plastic free environment and advocate elimination of single use plastic items.
