No.NBE-28/Ad-NCERT /2022-23 :: The G20 is the premier forum for international economic cooperation among its members who are the world's major economies, representing 85% of global economic output, two thirds of the world's population, and 75% of international trade. It comprises 19 countries and an organization of countries known as the European Union as members. The members of G20 are: Argentina, Australia, Brazil, Canada, China, France, Germany, India, Indonesia, Italy, Japan, Republic of Korea, Mexico, Russia, Saudi Arabia, South Africa, Türkey, United Kingdom and United States and the European Union.

You are aware that India has assumed the Presidency of the Group of Twenty (G20) from 01st December 2022, for a year and has re-emphasized that we are one of the most aspirational nation and also one of the youngest with median age being 29 years. The Hon'ble Prime Minister's vision for G20 Presidency is that 'India's G20 Presidency will work to promote this universal sense of one-ness'. Hence, our theme is "Vasudhaiva Kutumbakam" or "One Earth. One Family. One Future".

In this regard, the Ministry of Education, Department of School Education & Literacy, Government of India befits that if our school going children are given an opportunity to have a glimpse and understand the international scenario, its dynamics and India's position in it. This would facilitate and enable them to think critically, innovate, communicate and be a change maker.

The Board requests the schools to encourage students to learn and participate in these G20 activities. Schools shall conduct the suggested activities and select the best one from each category i.e. i. Classes VI to VIII and ii.
