NOTIFICATION NO.110/2024 Dated Kohima, the 5th November 2024

No.NBE-30/Ad-VIII/2024-25: The following is hereby notified again for the information of all the Heads of Registered Schools for the conduct of Phase-II Class VIII (Government schools only) and Class IX Examinations 2024.

- Phase-II Examination will be conducted from 26th November 2024 to 9th December 2024. Subject-wise division of syllabus for Phase II is uploaded in the Board's portal www.nbsenl.edu.in
- 2. Students must be made aware of the division in syllabus for Phase-II examination.
- 3. Question Paper design is uploaded in the Board's portal. No blueprint for these examinations will be given.
- 4. The Question papers of Class-VIII and Class IX subjects shall be as per the division of topics and marks uploaded in the Board's portal.
- 5. The Board shall provide Question papers for Class IX Examination of all the subjects to the schools.
- 6. The Board shall provide Class VIII Question papers to all Government schools, whereas the private schools shall prepare their own Question papers based on the Design of Question Paper uploaded in the portal and conduct the examination with the same routine for Class VIII Examination 2024.
- Similarly, all Private Schools shall conduct Phase-II Class VIII Examination 2024, and also follow the same assessment pattern.
- 8. Private schools shall prepare the Class VIII question papers for Phase II as per the Question Paper design uploaded in the portal. After the conduct of examinations. Private school shall mail the question paper in PDF format and mail to nbseqpaper@gmail.com within 17th December 2024.
- 9. Graph papers shall be required in Mathematics Class VIII (2 graph papers) and IX (1 graph paper) in Phase II Examination, therefore, schools should keep it ready.
- 10. The duration of Phase-II examination will be 90 minutes for core subjects and 60 minutes for the vocational/ sixth subjects.
- 11. The minimum qualifying marks in different subjects is given below.

- 12. The password file will be uploaded on 19th November 2024. The schools are to login to the portal and download the password file. The code for opening the password file will be sent via SMS to the registered mobile number of the schools given in the portal. Schools failing to download the question paper in time, are to inform the Board. Schools shall not share the Password, questions papers in the district WhatsApp groups.
- 13. Password protected PDF file Question papers for Phase-II examination will be uploaded in NBSE portal www.nbsenl.edu.in, on the same day of the examination at 7:00 am in the morning for every subject as per the routine.
- 14. Only the Head of Institution shall login to the portal and download the password file.
- 15. The Head of Institution shall maintain confidentiality of the PDF of the Question Papers. He/She shall ensure that printing of the question papers are done within the school office/premises only taking all strict measures to maintain confidentiality. The Head shall be held responsible for any lapse/leakage of the question paper as per rules.
- 16. Schools shall carry out the internal assessment in all the subjects and record the marks for inclusion in the final results preparation.
- 17. The consolidated marks of Phase-I & II with the internal assessment marks should be uploaded to the portal for approval on or before 17th December 2024.

- 18. Provision for retest and remedial measures for Class VIII as per RTE Act shall be followed by all the schools.
- 19. To reduce the failure rates/curtail dropout rates, schools must take remedial measures such as retest for slow learners/students who need special attention of Classes VIII & IX. School needs to intervene and plan strategies to mitigate the learning losses that has happened and such as, schools are advised to start remedial classes.
- 20. Special attention/remedial teaching must be given to slow learners and Students with Special Needs, to ensure that students achieve the expected learning outcomes in various subjects. Schools should also refer Notification 68/2022 dated 1-7-22, and take necessary remedial measures for the students.
- 21. Specimen signature and evaluated answer scripts can be submitted through speed post of each subject to the Secretary by 16th December 2024 as per the academic calendar.

In every subject, 3 (three) scripts of each range of marks shall be submitted for both Classes VIII & IX. The range of marks for the different subjects shall be as follows:

The scripts can be send by Speed Post. The remaining answer scripts should be kept for 6 (six) months in the school.

22. The retest results are to be submitted on or before 21st January 2025.

All Heads of Registered Schools are further directed to keep required infrastructure ready for the smooth conduct of the examination.

N.B: Schools must update their registered mobile number in the portal on or before 18th November 2024 in order to get the SMS.
