No.NBE-18/Ad-Misc(12)/2021-22 :: The following are hereby notified for information of all the Registered Heads of Higher Secondary Schools and Colleges:

- The admission of students in Class XI should be completed by 10th August 2021. 1.
- The admission given to students with the online generated marksheet must be 2. confirmed with the original marksheet-cum-pass certificate issued by the Board.
- 3. Higher Secondary Schools and Colleges should ensure that they admit students as per their available infrastructure. Classrooms should not be crammed or crowded. The teacher-student ratio of 40:1 must be maintained.
- Form 42 shall be uploaded by the Board from 1st to 6th September 2021. Care should be taken to enter the correct particulars of the students, subjects opted by the students while entering and submitting it to the Board.
- 5. Online/Offline classes should resume once admission process is over. While conducting offline classes for Class XI & XII, utmost care should be taken by the schools by strictly adhering to the SOPs issued by the Government vide No.GAB-1/COM/GEN-4/2020/148 dated 19.7.2021

Action will be taken against institutions who do not follow the SOPs issued by the Government.

- The particulars of Class XII in Form 46 should be submitted on or before 13th August 6. 2021. The form can also be sent through speed post.
- 7. The conduct of Mid-term Examination of Class XII shall be done with the "Assessment Guidelines 2021" issued on 20th June 2021. The last date of submission is 8th October 2021 as given in the Academic Calendar 2021.
- The Mid-term Assessment of Class XI should also be done with the "Assessment 8. Guidelines 2021". However, due to late declaration of HSLC results, academic activities should continue up to December along with assessment activities. The consolidated marks of the students shall be submitted from 13th to 17th December 2021 instead of 20th November 2021.
- Once the classes start, the teachers and the students should be encouraged to make use 9. of the available online resources which the Board had notified vide Notification No. 48/2021 dated 13th July 2021.
- 10. The Heads of Institutions are reminded to refer the revised Higher Secondary Syllabus and instruct their subject teachers to follow the changes in the weightage of marks in the different subjects.
