The quantitative expansion has raised the concern of quality which cannot be addressed through macro level strategies. It demands shifting of focus from system level reforms to school level actions. As such, empowering the school heads is an urgent need to transform schools into productive institutions.

The COVID-19 pandemic has caused unprecedented disruptions and massive changes in our education system. In this scenario, the Board is pleased to organize training on **School Leadership Program for the Heads of Secondary and Higher Secondary Institutions (Govt. & Private, Old & New)**. The training comprises of 6(six) Modules, with one Module planned every fortnightly in a dual-mode of offline/ online sessions, which will be held in the afternoon. The Second and Third Modules will be conducted offline on the 26th April 2022, while the rest of the Modules are online.
