**Category A:**

**Regular :**

- i) A student studying in a recognised school of this Board.
- ii) A student studying in a permitted school of this Board.

**Private :**

- i) A student who secured needs improvement in the last examination
- ii) A student who secured needs improvement for second or more times
- iii) A student marked eligible for compartmental in the HSLC examination 2026/HSLC Compartmental/ Improvement Examination 2026.

**The form shall be forwarded by the school where the student studied last.**

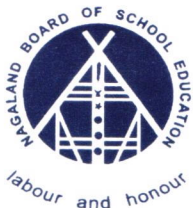
**Category B :**

**Change of Examination Centre :** Change of Examination Centre is permissible to Kohima Town only. A student seeking for change of centre shall download Form no. 19 from the portal and duly filled in Form should be scanned and email to [hslcorder@gmail.com](mailto:hslcorder@gmail.com)

**GUIDELINES FOR CHECKING AND FORWARDING OF APPLICATION FORMS FOR HSLC EXAMINATION**

- 1.(a) While filling up the forms, the candidate must know his/her Registration no. Candidates are to check if their particulars/details are correct in the form in respect of full name, surname, date of birth, father's name, mother's name, community to which they belong, Second language, sixth subject (if any) and the identification mark.
  - (b) Photo/Signature –
    - (i) Student/candidate should have a recent passport photo and signature in JPG/JPEG format.
    - (ii) Size of passport photo : 470 x 470 pixel (width x height)
    - (iii) Size of signature : 470 x 170 pixel (width x height)

***Or take photograph directly from the NBSE mobile app.***
  - (c) Heads of Institutions must check and ensure that all the students appearing from their institution have duly submitted their Online Applications.
  - (d) Certification/verification(online): The Head of registered school shall check the Application Form, the photograph, signature and all the entries made in the online by their students and be satisfied with it before it is forwarded to the Board.
2. (a) **Marks of Internal Assessment:**  
Form no. 32 shall be uploaded in the NBSE portal after the allotment of HSLC Roll numbers. Schools shall log in to the NBSE portal and enter the internal/practical marks.  
**Student who do not appear or fail to secure qualifying marks in the internal assessment shall not be eligible to sit for the external papers.**

**(b) Grades for Work & Art Education and Physical & Health Education :**

The internal assessment of Work & Art Education and Physical & Health Education must be entered in grades by the school in Form No.32 and submitted online.

**Students with E grades i.e. Needs Improvement/failed shall not be accepted.**

**3. Submission of certificates/order :**

For students with disabilities, a certificate from a competent authority identifying the disability must be obtained and the scanned copy shall be emailed to [hslcorder@gmail.com](mailto:hslcorder@gmail.com)

**4. Payment of Examination Fees :**

Schools shall collect the prescribed examination fees from the students and make online payment through the portal after verifying and confirming online submission for their students.

**INFORMATION**

1. The form of a candidate who do not have the qualifying grade/marks in the internal assessment in any of the subjects shall not be forwarded.
2. Schools/candidates are to note Notification dated Kohima, the 20<sup>th</sup> April 2026 that students who qualify either in Mathematics A or B and Science at HSLC Examination will be eligible to study Science stream and a student who qualify either in Mathematics A or B is eligible to study commerce stream in class XI. This must be made clear to the regular students.
3. Signing for another person in his/her name or putting thumb impression for another person in his/her place, is an act of deceiving and also forgery.\*
4. Examination centres shall be allotted by the Examination Committee of the Board.

**Category I:**

**Regular :**

A student studying in a registered hr. sec. school of this Board.

**Private :**

- i) A student who secured needs improvement in the last examination
- ii) A student who secured needs improvement for second or more times
- iii) A student marked eligible for compartmental in the HSSLC examination 2026/HSSLC Compartmental/ Improvement Examination 2026.

**The form shall be forwarded by the institution where the student studied last.**

**Category II**

**Change of Examination Centre :** Change of Examination Centre is permissible to Kohima Town only. A student seeking for change of centre shall download Form no. 50 from the portal and duly filled in Form should be scanned and email to [hsslcorder@gmail.com](mailto:hsslcorder@gmail.com)

**Online Submission of form:** Candidates are to visit [nbsenl.edu.in](http://nbsenl.edu.in) and fill the forms by following the steps given in the portal with intimation to the school where he /she is studying within the specified date and give their examination fee to their respective school.

**The particulars of the candidates are based on Class XI records as on 1<sup>st</sup> June. As such, any discrepancy or correction in the particulars must be applied in written separately.**

**GUIDELINES FOR CHECKING AND FORWARDING OF APPLICATION FORMS FOR HSSLC EXAMINATION**

1. (a) While filling up the forms, the candidate must know his/her Registration no. Candidates must check that their particulars/details are correct in the form in respect of full name, surname, date of birth, father's name, mother's name, community to which they belong, Second language, Optional subject (if any).
- (b) Photo/Signature – (i) Student/candidate shall scan a recent passport photograph and signature in JPG/JPEG format.  
(ii) Size of passport photo : 470 x 470 pixel (width x height)  
(iii) Size of signature : 470 x 170 pixel (width x height)  
***Or take photograph directly from the NBSE mobile app.***
- (c) The Principals must check and ensure that all the students appearing from his/her institution have submitted their Online Application Form.
- (d) Certification/verification(online): The Principal shall check/verify the Online Application Forms submitted by their students and be satisfied with it before it is forwarded to the Board.
- (e) Schools should forward the application of students with disabilities ( who have submitted their certificate ) stating the specific exemptions in examination to [hsslcorder@gmail.com](mailto:hsslcorder@gmail.com).



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2. **Marks of Internal Assessment and Grades for Work & Art Education and Physical Health Education:**

Form no. 63 shall be uploaded in the NBSE portal after the allotment of HSSLC Roll numbers. Institutions shall do the entry of internal/practical marks, grades and upload it in portal [nbsenl.edu.in](http://nbsenl.edu.in)

**Students who do not appear Internal examination or secure E grades in Internal Assessment subjects and failed marks in internal assessment in the subjects should not be uploaded.**

3. **Payment of Examination Fees :**

Institutions shall collect the prescribed examination fees from the students and make online payment in the portal after verifying and confirming online submission for their students.
