Preface

This report presents an analysis of the Performances at the Secondary and Higher Secondary levels, offering crucial information about how healthy and effective our educational system is. Building upon the last analytical exercise conducted by the Board in the year 2023, this study incorporates data from the academic years (2023-24) and (2024-25), specifically focusing on students in Classes IX and XI. Furthermore, it includes a meticulous examination of the Subjects Performances at the High School Leaving Certificate (HSLC) and Higher Secondary School Leaving Certificate (HSSLC) Examinations conducted in 2025. The primary objective is to shed light on important trends in students' progress, academic success and the effectiveness of Institutions.

The first part looks at how Institutions are performing at the Secondary and Higher Secondary levels, with a focus on Classes IX and XI Performances for the academic session (2023-24) and Classes X and XII for the academic session (2024-25). By examining Enrolment figures and Qualified/Pass Percentages during these critical years, we can better understand the effectiveness of teaching and learning processes. This basic analysis is intended to help understand how this batch of students moved through Secondary and Higher Secondary levels.

Subsequently, we take a closer look at the performances in the different subjects at the HSLC and HSSLC Examinations 2025. This is divided into three separate categories:

- 1. District Qualified/Pass Percentages compared to the State Mean Percentage,
- 2. Gender Performance at Government and Private Institutions across all districts, and
- 3. Districts Mean Score versus the State Mean Score.

The charts identify districts that are doing well, those that are falling behind, and the overall difference in academic performance across the state. It also looks into the link between high Qualified Percentages and high Mean Scores, giving an increased understanding of academic excellence. The charts show the findings in a way that is easy to understand, giving a clear picture of the analytical results.

I hope that this report will serve as an invaluable resource for stakeholders, educators, and policymakers, guiding strategic decisions and resource allocation to continuously enhance the quality of education and foster academic excellence across all levels. I thank all the officers involved in bringing out this report in the shortest possible time.

Evaluating Institutions Performances at the Secondary level: Enrolment and Qualification

Introduction

Robust evaluation metrics are crucial for driving continuous improvement and ensuring student success within the Secondary Education system. This document outlines key indicators designed to assess Institution's Performance at the Secondary level:

1. Class IX in the academic session (2023-24):

- (a) **Enrolment:** The total number of students registered in Class IX during the academic year (2023-24). This reflects a school's capacity and reach at the entry point of the Secondary level.
- (b) Qualified Percentage: The percentage of Class IX students who successfully met the promotion criteria namely, Phase I and II Class IX Board's Examinations, along with internal assessments to advance to Class X in the academic year (2024-25). This demonstrates the effectiveness of the teaching and learning process and student preparedness for the next stage.

2. Class X in the academic session (2024-25):

- (a) **Enrolment:** The total number of students registered in Class X during the academic year (2024-25). This allows for a comparison with the previous year's Class IX enrolment to assess student retention and progression within the Secondary level.
- (b) Qualified Percentage: The percentage of Class X students who successfully qualified their Final examinations (e.g., HSLC Examination) in the academic year (2024-25), thereby enabling progression to the Higher Secondary level. This is a crucial indicator of an Institution's overall academic success and its ability to prepare students for significant academic milestones.

Key Insights from this Analysis

By analysing both Enrolment and Qualified Percentages across these two consecutive academic years for Secondary level, stakeholders can gain insights into:

- (a) **Student Progression and Retention:** Assessing the effectiveness of student retention and progression strategies from Class IX to Class X. A critical issue is the decline in Secondary Enrolment. This includes Institutions where Class IX Enrolment doesn't translate into a Class X cohort, or where students leave before taking their Board Examinations. These significant gaps in student progression require urgent attention and effective solutions
- (b) **Academic Effectiveness**: An institution's ability to prepare students to meet academic standards at different stages of the Secondary level.
- (c) **Performance Trends**: Identifying areas of underperformance or positive trends in academic results over time.
- (d) **Resource Allocation and Support Needs:** Understanding where additional support or interventions might be required to improve student success as a result of this analysis.

Noteworthy Observations: Enrolment and Retention Challenges

It has been observed that certain Institutions are implementing a screening process at Class IX level. This appears to be a strategy to enhance their performance metrics in the subsequent Class X (HSLC) Examination. This practice leads to the following concerning outcomes:

Declining Secondary Level Enrolment: These Institutions are not maintaining the Class IX Enrolment figures into Class X. This directly contributes to a noticeable decline in overall Enrolment at the Secondary level.

Increased Student Dropout Rates: The rising student dropout rate is often linked to students not qualifying the Class IX - Phase I and/or II Examinations, leading them to either leave school or secure a Qualified Transfer Certificate, and ultimately failing to complete the two-year Secondary Education curriculum.

The Board previously ceased the practice of publishing individual Institutions' Qualified Percentages in the HSLC Examination Gazette. This measure was intended to discourage Institutions from making decisions primarily aimed at inflating their pass rates.

However, it's evident that some Institutions persist in disproportionately removing students enrolled in Class IX. This remains a significant concern, and we urge all stakeholders to cooperate in discontinuing such practices, which hinder our students' academic advancement within the state.

Introduction

Robust evaluation metrics are crucial for driving continuous improvement and ensuring student success within the Higher Secondary Education system. This document outlines key indicators designed to assess Institution's Performance at the Higher Secondary level:

1. Class XI in the academic session (2023-24):

- (a) **Enrolment:** The total number of students registered in Class XI during the academic year (2023-24). This reflects a school's capacity and reach at the entry point of the Higher Secondary level.
- (b) Qualified Percentage: The percentage of Class XI students who successfully met the promotion criteria— namely, Class XI Promotion Examination, along with internal assessments— to advance to Class XII in the academic year (2024-25). This demonstrates the effectiveness of the teaching and learning process and student preparedness for the next stage.

2. Class XII in the academic session (2024-25):

- (a) **Enrolment:** The total number of students registered in Class XII during the academic year (2024-25). This allows for a comparison with the previous year's Class XI Enrolment to assess student retention and progression within the Higher Secondary level.
- (b) **Qualified Percentage:** The percentage of Class XII students who successfully qualified their Final examinations (e.g., HSSLC Examination) in the academic year (2024-25), thereby enabling progression to higher education. This is a crucial indicator of an Institution's overall academic success and its ability to prepare students for significant academic milestones.

Key Insights from this Analysis

By analysing both Enrolment and Pass Percentages across these two consecutive academic years for Higher Secondary level, stakeholders can gain insights into:

- (a) **Student Progression and Retention:** Assessing the effectiveness of student retention and progression strategies for Higher Secondary level. The most pressing concerns are Institutions grappling with declining student enrolment from Class XI to Class XII. Such substantial losses in student continuity highlight a critical need for immediate intervention and effective strategies.
- (b) **Academic Effectiveness**: An institution's ability to prepare students to meet academic standards at different stages of the Higher Secondary level.
- (c) **Performance Trends**: Identifying areas of underperformance or positive trends in academic results over time.
- (d) **Resource Allocation and Support Needs:** Understanding where additional support or interventions might be required to improve student success as a result of this analysis

Noteworthy Observations: Enrolment and Retention Challenges

It has been observed that certain Institutions are implementing a screening process at Class XI level. This appears to be a strategy to enhance their performance metrics in the subsequent Class XII (HSSLC) Examination. This practice leads to the following concerning outcomes:

Declining Higher Secondary Level Enrolment: These Institutions are not maintaining the Class XI Enrolment figures into Class XII. This directly contributes to a noticeable decline in overall Enrolment at the Higher Secondary level.

Increased Student Dropout Rates: The rising student dropout rate is often linked to students not qualifying the Class XI Examinations, leading them to either leave school or secure a Pass Transfer Certificate, and ultimately failing to complete the two-year Higher Secondary Education curriculum.

The Board previously ceased the practice of publishing individual Institutions' Pass Percentages in the HSSLC Examination Gazette. This measure was intended to discourage Institutions from making decisions primarily aimed at inflating their pass rates.

However, it's evident that some Institutions persist in disproportionately removing students enrolled in Class XI. This remains a significant concern, and we urge all stakeholders to cooperate in discontinuing such practices, which hinder our students' academic advancement within the state.

Analysis of Subjects Performances at the HSLC & HSSLC Examinations 2025

Introduction

The High School Leaving Certificate (HSLC) and Higher Secondary School Leaving Certificate (HSSLC) Examinations represent a pivotal milestone for students and serve as critical indicators of the educational landscape within the state. To pinpoint areas of notable strength and identify challenges that require future intervention, an in-depth analysis has been conducted on the performance of 25 subjects in the HSLCE 2025 and 36 subjects in the HSSLCE 2025 across all districts.

Study Categories

The analysis is structured into three primary categories:

1. District Qualified/Pass Percentages and Standard Deviation Compared to State Mean

The primary objective of this category is to compare the Qualification/Pass Percentages of candidates at the district level against the State Mean Percentage for every subject.

Parameters Utilized:

(a) **District Qualified/Pass Percentage:** This represents the percentage of candidates from each district who successfully qualified or passed the HSLC and HSSLC Examinations 2025, relative to the total number of students who appeared from that district.

District Qualified/Pass Percentage =

(b) **State Mean Percentage:** This denotes the average Qualified /Pass Percentage across all districts in the state for the HSLC and HSSLC Examinations 2025.

(c) Standard Deviation (across all subjects): The Standard Deviation of Qualified/Pass Percentages across districts for each subject is calculated. This metric illuminates the variability or spread of performance across different subjects within the state. A high Standard Deviation suggests significant disparities in subject-wise qualifying rates among districts.

Points for Consideration:

- (a) **Superior Performance:** Districts demonstrating Qualified/Pass Percentages significantly above the State Mean indicate robust academic performance and effective educational practices. These could serve as models for best practices.
- (b) Areas for Intervention: Districts with Qualified /Pass Percentages significantly below the State Mean highlight areas that may necessitate targeted interventions and support mechanisms.
- (c) Average Performance: Districts performing close to the State Mean suggest an average level of academic achievement.

(d) Impact of Standard Deviation:

- i. Low Standard Deviation: A low Standard Deviation for Qualified/Pass Percentages in in a subject signifies consistent performance across districts, suggesting a balanced and uniform educational approach.
- ii. **High Standard Deviation:** A high Standard Deviation points to considerable variations in subject-wise performance across districts. This could imply that candidates are excelling in certain subjects while facing significant challenges in others.

2. Gender Performance across Government and Private Institutions.

The central objective of this section is to examine disparities in performance between genders within both Government and Private Institutions across all districts.

Parameters Utilized:

(a) **Disaggregated Qualified/Pass Percentages:** Qualified/Pass Percentages have been broken down by institution type (Government/Private) and by gender (Male/Female) for each district.

Points for Consideration:

- (a) **Gender Performance Gaps:** To investigate the presence and nature of any significant gender gaps in subject-specific performance, identifying which gender performs better in particular subjects.
- (b) **Institutional Impact on Gender Performance:** To determine if gender performance significantly differs based on the type of institution (Government vs. Private).
- (c) **Pronounced Disparities:** To identify specific subjects and districts where gender disparities are more accentuated in one type of institution compared to the other.

3. Districts Mean Score versus State Mean Score.

The primary aim of this section is to offer a direct comparison of the average academic achievement of candidates in each district against the overall State Mean Score.

Parameters Utilized:

(a) **District Mean Score:** This is calculated as the average aggregate score (*inclusive of Internal and External Assessments*) of all students in the subjects from each respective district.

(b) State Mean Score: This represents the overall average aggregate score (inclusive of Internal and External Assessments) of all students in the subjects across the entire state.




- (a) **Academic Excellence:** Districts demonstrating significantly higher Mean Scores than the State Mean Score indicate academic excellence and could serve as potential models for best practices.
- (b) **Educational Quality Concerns:** Districts with significantly lower Mean Scores suggest that educational quality in such subjects may be lagging.
- (c) Assessment Discrepancies: Districts with significantly higher Mean Scores than their Qualified/Pass Percentages may indicate stronger performance in Internal Assessments but weaker performance in External Assessments.
- (d) **Disparity in Achievement:** To analyse the range of Mean Scores across districts to comprehend the overall disparity in academic achievement within the state.
- (e) Correlation with Qualification: To analyse whether a high Qualified/Pass Percentage in districts correlates positively with a high Mean Score, indicating comprehensive academic success.


