Sir/Madam,

This is to inform all the registered institutions of the Board that the Class VIII Final examination for the Government schools only will be conducted based on the syllabus given in the Annexure attached. This is based on the syllabus of Class VIII prepared by the SCERT. However, due to the unprecedented situation caused by the COVID-19 pandemic and subsequent lockdown of the educational institutions, certain modifications have been done keeping in mind the interest of the students.

The Topics or Units which are not included in the *Annexure* for external examination have to be assessed by the schools internally based on the concept of CCE which is being followed by the Board. The marks for the internal assessment will remain the same i.e. 20 marks.

The schools will maintain a proper record of the internal assessment done and the marks secured by the students shall be submitted to this office along with the final result of the external examination.

The Board shall conduct the Class VIII Final Examination 2020 based on the syllabus given in the *Annexure* only. The marks for the final examination will remain the same i.e. 80 marks. The same marking pattern shall also be followed by the private schools for the conduct of Class VIII Final examination.

Schools are reminded and requested again to encourage their students to view the DD telecast of the lessons for Class VIII. All possible measures may kindly be initiated by the schools to support the students learning in these times of crisis. Secondly, guidelines issued by the Government of Nagaland from time to time should be adhered to.
